COUNCIL MATTERS

At January's meeting councillors discussed the precept—the Parish Council's part of Swindon Borough Council's Council Tax. It was set at £39.02 (annual, Band D), which means this is the ninth year there has been no increase in the amount levied by the Parish Council for homes in the villages. Other matters arising included:

A litter pick to be arranged for Sunday 27th February. Volunteers should meet at the village halls at 10am.

Residents are to be encouraged to download the British Horse Society's Horsei app to gather data for possible new equine road safety signs.

Muddy paths, including Nell Hill to the Ridgeway, which had previously benefitted from having wood chippings laid, to be given another layer of cover.

S/HOU/21/1654 Installation of 14no. solar PV panels on south east facing roofs of house and detached garage at Garstons Mead, Church Lane Bishopstone.
